
**Payment Methodologies**  
**DD Waiver - ISSH - ICF/MR**  
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**Developmental Disability Waiver**  

- Idaho Code – 56-118 passed in 2005
- Specific provider groups identified in the statute
- In 2009, the provider agency groups have come to an agreement with the proposed reimbursement methodology



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**Provider Groups**  

- Residential Habilitation in a Certified Family Home
- Residential Habilitation Agency Affiliation
- DD Agencies
- Residential Habilitation
- Mental Health Clinic
- Rehab Mental Health
- Service Coordination



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## Reimbursement Methodology

- Collected actual cost data from providers
- Used Idaho Bureau of Labor Statistics wage rate for each service provider
- Employer Related Costs, Program Related Costs, and General and Administrative costs added
- Adjust target rate based on current wages paid



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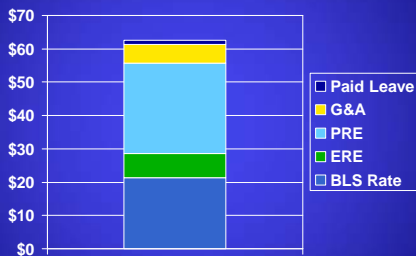
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## Target Rate Calculation Example



G&A – General and Administrative  
PRE – Program Related Expenses  
ERE – Employer Related Expenses

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## % of Target Rate

- Range from approximately 40% to 100% of proposed rate depending on the current rate.
- Budget requests made to fund the proposed methodology for the past two years have been disapproved.



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## Exceptions to New Methodology

- Residential Habilitation in a Certified Family Home – Working on a new reimbursement methodology
- Residential Habilitation Agency Affiliation – On hold
- Service Coordination – Rate set 7/1/09 utilizing billable and non-billable time % from survey data



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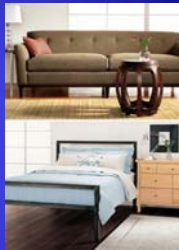
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## Room and Board

- Participants pay for their room and board through their own income
- DD waiver service costs are not usually reduced by any cost sharing by the participant



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## ISSH

- Cost-based reimbursement
- Medicaid allowable costs only
- No cap on daily rate



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## ISSH

- Patient Care Services
- Active Treatment
- Utilities
- Property
- Major Movable Equipment
- Day Treatment



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## ISSH Room and Board

- Participants assist in payment for their room and board through their own income
- Medicaid payments are reduced by participant payment of room and board



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## ICF/MR

- Prospective payment reimbursement
- A cap is calculated for reimbursement
- Medicaid payments will not be paid over the cap

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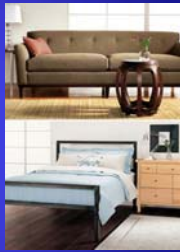
